# *The Creed*

before all worlds,**

**God of God, Light of Light,  
very God of very God,  
begotten, not made,  
being of one substance  
with the Father,  
by whom all things were made:**

**who for us men and for our salvation  
came down from heaven,  
and was incarnate by the Holy Ghost  
of the Virgin Mary,  
and was made man,**

**and was crucified also for us under  
Pontius Pilate.**

**He suffered and was buried,**

**and the third day he rose again  
according to the Scriptures,  
and ascended into heaven,  
and sitteth on the right hand  
of the Father.**
