A Prayer to use before Holy Communion

ALMIGHTY God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hidden: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you, and worthily magnify your holy Name; through Christ our Lord. Amen.

1. Coming Together as God's people

Priest

+ In the name of the Father and of the Son

and of the Holy Spirit.

All Amen.

Priest The Lord be with you.

All And also with you.

Words of Welcome

2. Putting things right with God

The priest introduces a time for reflection in which we call to mind our sins. After each petition:

Priest Lord, have mercy.

All Lord, have mercy.

Priest Christ, have mercy.

All Christ, have mercy.

Priest Lord, have mercy.

All Lord, have mercy.

The priest pronounces the assurance of God's forgiveness, to which all respond **Amen**.

3. The Prayer for the Week

This week's prayer, the Collect, is said,

At the end of the prayer, we all say,

All Amen

When Young Church is meeting in the Crypt, children and Parent Helpers are invited to gather in front of the Choir Steps for their gathering prayer.

4. Listening to God's Word in Scripture

A reading from the Old or New Testament

At the end of the first reading

Priest This is the word of the Lord.

All Thanks be to God.

Before the reading of the Gospel we stand,

Priest The Lord be with you.

All And also with you.

Reader **All**

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Saint *N*. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

After the Gospel is read

This is the Gospel of the Lord.

All Praise to you, O Christ.

The Homily, during which Young Church members are invited to gather in front of the Choir Steps if there is no Young Church gathering in the Crypt.

5. Saying what we believe

Priest Let us declare the faith of the Church,

All We believe in God the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named.
We believe in God the Son, who lives in our hearts through faith, and fills us with his love.
We believe in God the Holy Spirit, who strengthens us with power from on high. Amen.

6. Talking and listening to God

After each part of our prayers

Lord, in your mercy

All hear our prayer.

At the end of the prayers

All Merciful Father, accept these prayers for the sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.

7. Sharing Christ's Peace

After reading a sentence from Scripture, the priest says

Priest The peace of the Lord be with you:

All and also with you.

Let us share with one another a sign of Christ's peace.

We greet each other with words "Peace be with you!"

8. Giving to God

A collection for the work of the parish church and bread and wine are brought to the altar.

9. The Church's Great 'Thank You' Prayer

Priest The Lord be with you:

All and also with you.

Priest Lift up your hearts.

All We lift them to the Lord.

Priest Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All It is right to give thanks and praise.

The priest praises God for his mighty acts and all say,

All Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory.

Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

Hosanna in the highest.

The priest recalls the Last Supper, and this Acclamation is used

Priest Great is the mystery of faith:

All Christ has died! Christ is risen! Christ will come again!

The priest brings the prayer to an end, and everyone says really loudly,

All Amen.

10. The Lord's Prayer

Priest Let us pray as Jesus taught his disciples to pray,

All Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory for ever and ever. Amen.

11. God giving to us

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ.

All
